Welcome Back

The Club asks all players to abide by the following rules during these extraordinary times. Please play your part in keeping the Club and our other Members safe.

- If you (or anyone in your household) are feeling unwell, particularly with any of the Covid 19 symptoms – please stay at home and do not come to the Club.
- All sessions are only available to Members, and booked in advance. No more than two households per rink and no more than six players per rink.
- All rinks must be booked by phone on 0116 2532366. Rinks can be pre-booked while at the club also.
- Face Masks are not mandatory for bowling, however if you wish to wear one they can be purchased at the club.
- The Main Entrance is now the EXIT. Access will not be granted. The new entrance is the fire doors next to the bar. These are accessed via the road at the side of the building. The entrance will be signposted.
- Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes before your session at the new entrance.
- On arrival, you will have your temperature checked (contactless) and pay your rink fees to the member of staff (contactless if possible) at the Bar. Once paid you will be asked to swipe into the rink on the touchscreen computer – this is to ensure we can track and trace all visitors.
- Please do not touch the screen as it will be done for you by the Bar Staff.
- Please follow the one-way systems inside the building. These are clearly signposted.
- Toilet facilities will be reduced to one person at a time to allow social distancing.
- Please be considerate to other members when going to/from the toilets, or to the rink side at the start and end of sessions.
- Hand sanitisers are available around the Club – please use them.
- Do not plan to use your lockers. The changing rooms are closed. Arrive in the clothes you are to play in. Your bowls and shoes in a bag for ease of carrying. (Please change into your bowls shoes only after you are in the Bar Lounge.)
- The Dress Code has been relaxed for social bowling.
- Each rink has a designated table and chairs. Wait at your designated table for all the rinks to clear. Move to the rinks when instructed.
- You may leave belongings, coats etc. at these tables.
- You will be provided with two jacks, two mats and a scorecard. (No pens will be given out)
- The scoreboards are not being used.
- Each session will be 1 hour 45 mins to allow for disinfecting between sessions. The cost will remain at £3.
- To assist with payments we are offering 14 hours bowling (8 sessions) at £20. That's a saving of £4. You will be given a card which will need to be shown on each arrival at the club.
- One jack will be placed at each end of the green and placed with your foot at the start of each end. The jack must be placed at a legal length as determined by the laws of the sport.
- If the jack is struck into the ditch it will be re-spotted on the T.
- If the jack is struck out of the rink then it will be re-spotted on the appropriate spot.

- Only spray chalk is to be used.
- Players should try to maintain a 2 metre distance from other players at the same end, both sideways and along the rink. Use the bank whenever spacing reason dictates.
- The Club advises members that they should maintain the social distancing when they are changing ends. Movement up and down the rink should be in single file while maintaining the 2 metre distance.
- Jacks and mats are to be placed in a "Dirty" box at the Exit at the session end.
- Members may use the bar and restaurant facilities before, during and after matches but must be seated in the restaurant area. Please note there is a maximum capacity of 48 people in the restaurant area.
- Leave by the marked EXIT (former entrance).
- By booking a making a payment for the rink each player is abiding by the regulations set out above.
- Any person found not to be following the above regulations may be asked to leave and without a refund of any monies paid.
- All the above regulations are under constant review in line with the current government and EIBA advice. Any changes will be distributed accordingly.

The aim of these regulations is to provide a safe environment for members to play indoor bowls and use the club facilities. All aspects of this document have been reviewed by the Management Committee of Leicester Indoor Bowls Club and agreed that the best safe practice adhered to in line with the current UK Government, EIBA and Leicester City Council recommendations.
